Enjoy a 2-mile, moderate paced hike at Oakes Quarry Park. This Fairborn City park, the highest point in Fairborn, is part of the Beaver Creek Wetlands and is best known for its unique geological formations.

We'll hike part of the perimeter trail and also part of the quarry basin area to view some interesting features of the park. The path is dirt, gravel, and rock with some inclines. Wear hiking boots or tennis shoes. Bring water. Hiking poles recommended.
