

# FAIRBORN CITY PARKS

The City of Fairborn has a special commitment to recreational areas. The city maintains 714.53 acres of park land consisting of 20 parks, a nature reserve and a bikeway.

## MAKING A RESERVATION

Our park facilities are available to the public on a first-come, first-serve basis. If you're planning a group function, reserving a shelter for your event is highly recommended.

### SHELTER RESERVATION FEE

- Residents - \$10
- Non-residents - \$25

### ATHERTON AMPHITHEATER FEE

- Residents - \$25
- Non-residents - \$50

- Picnic shelters and the amphitheater can be reserved from late March to the end of October. Reservations are accepted starting February 1.
- To reserve a facility, go online to [ci.fairborn.oh.us](http://ci.fairborn.oh.us) and select the link to "Reserve a Shelter". All reservations are processed through our website and can be paid for online.
- Applicants may be required to submit a letter for large group functions. The letter should address the park use, an explanation of the group, security, anticipation of a crowd, concessions, times, dates, etc.
- Restrooms open April 15.

## RULES & REGULATIONS

Fairborn's park areas are intended for the recreation and enjoyment of our residents and their guests. Park patrons are expected to refrain from behavior that affects the safety, peace, and good order of the parks and park visitors. The parks are open daily from sunrise to dusk. The grounds and parking lots must be vacated at closing.

- Structures, plants, and the natural features may not be removed, damaged or defaced.
- No littering or dumping. Picnic areas must be clean and orderly after use.
- Fires may be built in grills or fireplaces only, must be attended at all times and extinguished prior to leaving.
- Dogs and cats must be leashed and must not foul in public areas. Clean up is the owners responsibility.
- Skateboards, roller blades, and bicycles are prohibited on walking paths as well as basketball and tennis courts.
- Motor vehicles must remain on designated roads and parking lots. No driving or parking on the grass and/or walking paths. No parking permitted in the Service/Office driveway. Dirt bikes, mini-bikes, and ATV's are prohibited.



# RULES & REGULATIONS

Continued

- Beer, alcohol, and drugs of abuse are prohibited.
- Swimming, boating, and ice skating are prohibited.
- Fireworks, and explosives are prohibited.
- No person may hunt, trap, or endanger animals in any way.
- Sales, solicitation or placement of any signs within the parks requires permission from the City Manager.
- Those using the amphitheater must adhere to the noise ordinance and may be asked to submit a letter of intent showing the type of activity, proof of financial responsibility, etc.
- Shelters, courts, and fields are available on a first-come basis unless previously reserved.
- Special rules apply to the Spray Ground, Skate Park and Oakes Quarry Park. These rules are posted at the parks.
- Further restrictions may apply as set by the City and/or Parks & Recreation Superintendent.
